This is a Reform UK Scotland Position Paper

One feature of governance that has come as a surprise to many of us since 2020 has been the emergence into the public view of several supra-national bodies. In particular, the World Economic Forum (WEF) has shed its previous public image as the organiser of an annual jolly for obscenely rich individuals to expose its apparent true purpose of world domination.

The WEF now boasts of its influence over national governments, notably Canada, New Zealand and the Netherlands. They are slightly more reticent over the involvement of British politicians, but many senior Conservatives are members and the government is implementing WEF policies. The leader of the WEF, Klaus Schwab, recently addressed the G20 conference in Indonesia with the apparent status of a national leader, although unelected by anyone.

The WEF advocates courses of action - especially in energy generation and food production - that we believe will badly damage economies and public health, resulting in many deaths. We think this is capable of being interpreted as terrorism in the UK under the terms of the Terrorism Act 2000*.

Nobody here voted for the WEF. Reform UK Scotland calls on all UK administrations to abjure any connection with this unaccountable organisation and place the governance of Scotland and the UK back into the hands of the British electorate.
